

Reversed colour Logo on dark background.


Logo - Grayscale



Clear Space

To maintain the integrity of the Company logo, it must be kept clear of all other graphics and type.

As shown here, the logo should always have a minimum clearance zone around it. This ensures clarity of communication and prevents the logo from being lost or crowded.

As a guide, the minimum distance of clear space required around the logo equates to the width of the letters "AN" from 'Diocesan'.




Minimum Size


Incorrect Logo Use
